

Clinical Scenarios Suggesting the Use of Dupilumab for EoE

1st

Consider first-line use

- Multiple comorbid atopic conditions:
 - Moderate, persistent, or difficult-to-control asthma
 - Moderate, persistent, or difficult-to-control AD
 - Difficult-to-control CRSwNP
- Strong patient preference to avoid dietary restriction or topical swallowed steroids



Consider as step-up therapy

- Difficult-to-treat EoE
- Failure to thrive, poor growth, or significant weight loss due to EoE
- Frequent rescue therapy use (oral systemic steroids, esophageal dilations)
- Severe diet restriction or requirement for amino acid formula
- Clinically significant esophageal strictures or narrow caliber esophagus
- Refractory to current therapy due to:
 - Continued symptoms
 - Persistent abnormal esophageal inflammation
 - AEs of current therapy
 - Intolerance of current therapy
 - Unable to adhere to current therapy
- AEs to current therapy
